

GEN 1.0 NATIONAL REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS**GEN 1.1 DESIGNATED AUTHORITIES**

1. The addresses of the designated authorities concerned with facilitation of international military air navigation are as follows:

(a) **Civil Aviation**

(b) **Military Aviation**

Authorised Owners of Sections of the UK Mil AIP.

The UK Military Aeronautical Information Publication (UK Mil AIP) is published by the authority of Officer Commanding No 1 Aeronautical Information Documents Unit (No 1 AIDU). The various sections within the Mil AIP are allocated authorised owners who are responsible for maintaining the accuracy of their respective sections. These owners (e.g MAA, DAATM, DoD (USAF) and ADHs) supply that information to the unit who is responsible for publishing it on behalf of OC No 1 AIDU.

(c) **Meteorology**

Defence Met Unit (DMU) (embedded with UK Met Office HQ)

The DMU is located at UKMO HQ and is responsible for the provision of routine meteorological services to the Royal Air Force and the Army. The DMU has a global forecasting capability and provides support to Land and Air operations and exercises at home and overseas.
